













Instructions



Students will use a dice to roll a colored pom pom. The student will then find a matching pom pom and place it on the mat. The student will then place a tally mark on the recording sheet next to the matching color.

Students will keep rolling, matching, and tallying until the mat is full. Once the mat is full, students will count each tally and record the total in the number column on the recording sheet.
