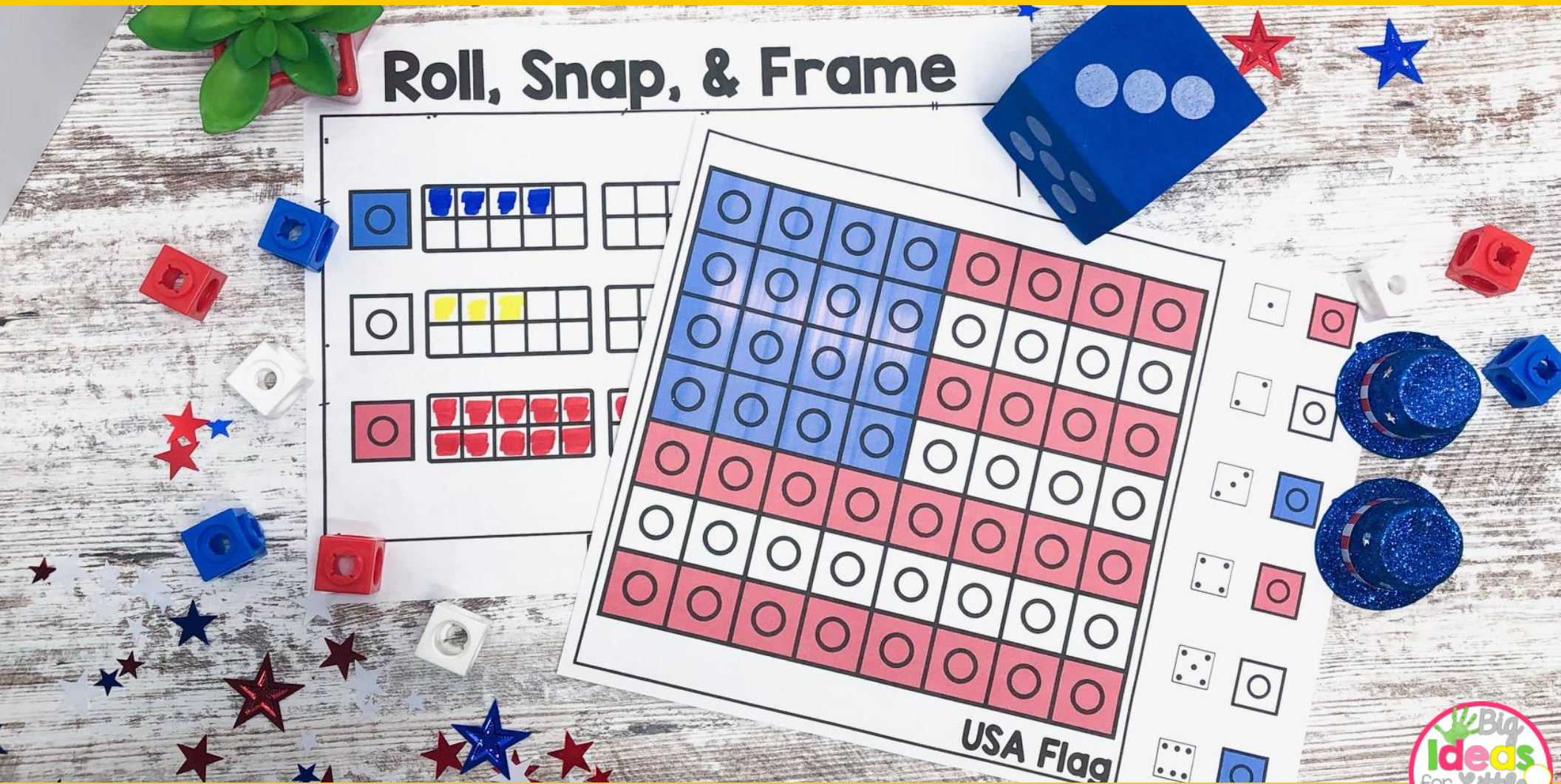

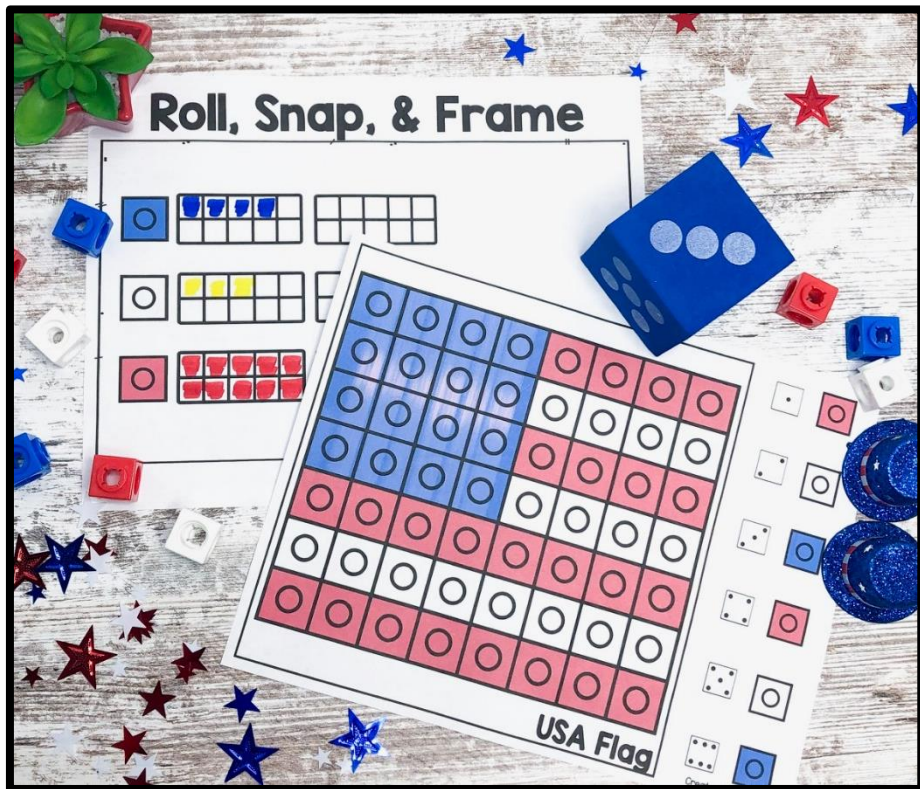

# Instructions

## Roll, Snap, & Frame



Students will use a dice to roll a colored snap cube. The student will then find a matching snap cube and place it on the mat. The student will then color in one square on the ten frame recording sheet beside the matching color. Students will keep rolling, matching, and coloring until the mat is full.




