



Teacher Tips

Prepare Materials

- scissors
- glue
- markers, crayons, or colored pencils
- copies of lapbook pages
- file folder, construction paper, or notebook (fold one side to the middle, then fold the other side to the middle







2 Create Lapbook

- Break the activities up into different days or sessions.
 I like to do one activity (flap) a day.
- Students will cut & glue each flap to the folder and complete the activity.
- Complete various activities throughout the week to place into folder.
- · Decorate the front.
- Bring home to share with families.
