

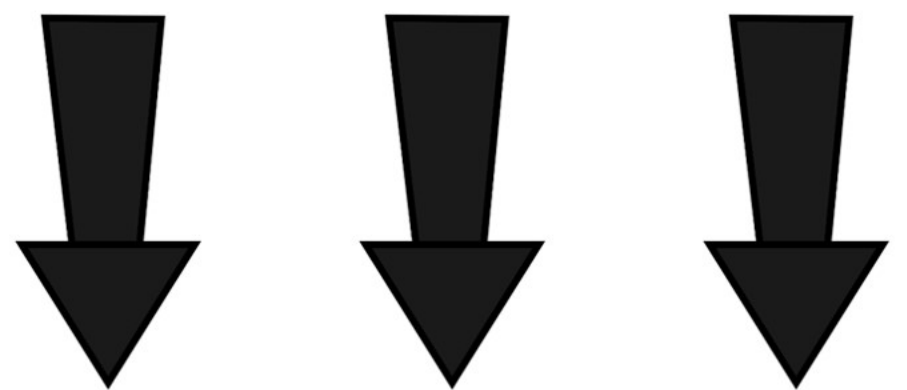

# Teacher Led Games

Each activity has a teacher direction page and a variety of options to allow for game play throughout the school year!

## Match & Cover

- Materials:
- Match and Cover Board
  - Match and Cover Cards

- Directions:
1. Students will get a board and a set of cards to go with the board.
  2. Students will cover the pictures on the board with the matching rhyming words.



## Thumbs Up/Thumbs Down

- Materials:
- Print a thumbs up/thumbs down set for each student. Glue back to back onto a popsicle stick.
  - Rhyming Words Pair Cards

- Directions:
1. Give each student a thumbs up/thumbs down stick.
  2. Show students a rhyming pair card.
  3. Students will hold up the thumbs up side if the pictures



## Trash It!

- Materials:
- Rhyming Picture Strips
  - Trash Can cut outs

- Directions:
1. Student will pick a rhyming picture strip.
  2. Student will find the picture on the strip that does not rhyme (does not belong) and remove it by placing the trash can on the picture.



## SWAT!

- Materials:
- Fly Rhyming Cards
  - Fly Swatter
  - Calling Cards

- Directions:
1. Teacher will scatter the rhyming pictures being practiced on the table.
  2. The teacher will call out a rhyme using the calling cards. The first student to find the rhyme and "swat" the picture with the fly swatter can keep the fly card.
  3. The teacher will keep calling rhymes and repeating until the cards are gone.



## Fruit Salad

- Materials:
- 1 Bowl for each student
  - Fruit Rhyming Picture Cards
  - Calling Cards

- Directions:
1. Teacher will place 10-20 pictures scattered in middle of table. Each student will get one bowl.
  2. The teacher will pick a calling card and tell a student to put a fruit in the bowl that rhymes with \_\_\_\_\_. Ex: "Can you put a fruit in the bowl that rhymes with horn?" When the student finds the picture that rhymes, they will place it in their bowl.
  3. The teacher will continue asking students to make a fruit salad, one at a time until all pictures are gone.



## Feed Me!

- Materials:
- Fish face down in a bowl
  - Calling Card sheet if desired

- Directions:
1. Student will pick a rhyming fish. If the fish rhymes with the fish in the bowl, place it off to the side.
  2. Student will turn and pick a new fish. If the fish rhymes with the fish in the bowl, place it off to the side.

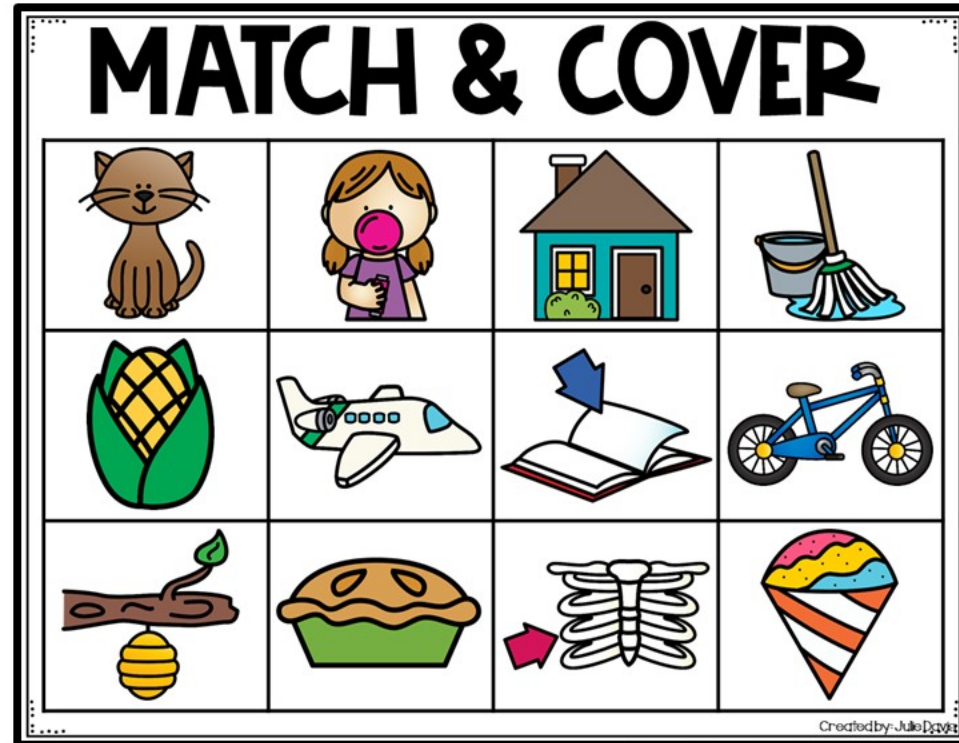

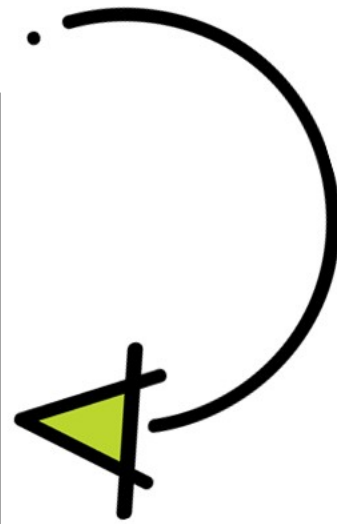
