






• Prepare Materials

- scissors
- glue
- markers, crayons, or colored pencils
- copies of lapbook pages
- file folder, construction paper, or notebook (fold one side to the middle, then fold the other side to the middle





Create Lapbook Break the activities up into different days or sessions. I like to do one activity (flap) a day. Students will cut & glue each flap to the folder and

- complete the activity.
- Complete various activities throughout the week to place into folder.
- Decorate the front.
- Bring home to share with families.







Each template has step by step directions to tell you how to cut and fold each flap!










